✓ Yes on Measure F

Tuesday, November 7th, is the general election. Measure F will be on the ballot again this year. If approved, this measure will help maintain the quality of a well-rounded education for our children.

What is Measure F?

This measure is a flat tax of \$65 per parcel. The tax would be in place for 8 years and would cost \$5.42 per month.

Funds from Measure F would:

- Assist in keeping Wilson class sizes small
- Keep our library open
- Maintain student counseling services
- Keep vocal and instrumental music classes and activities
- Provide current technology for all students
- Protect academic excellence

Why is Measure F on the ballot?

During the last economic recession Wilson teachers and staff voted to take furlough days in order to be true to our previous voter-approved parcel tax and not cut programs like music, counseling, library, and technology and keep class sizes small. We need your help to solidify the funding for these programs for the students at Wilson School.
