# 3.0 Reports/presentations:

**3.0** Superintendent/Principal: Mid Year LCAP Update

Superintendent Hospodar and CBO Hale delivered the mid-year LCAP update, presenting a comprehensive review of each of the four LCAP goals to the school board. A mid-year snapshot was shared, offering insights into the progress made. Furthermore, the budget associated with the LCAP was scrutinized, with a comparison between estimated and actual costs at this juncture in the academic year. CBO Hale also provided an updated overview of general fund budget expenditures for the school year, excluding those covered by the LCAP.

# 3.1 Business Manager: Mid Year LCAP Fiscal Update

CBO Hale briefed the school board on the proposed Governor's budget, highlighting a substantial \$38 billion deficit facing the state of California. Despite the challenging financial landscape, there was some positive news. According to the governor's presentation, there won't be a significant decrease in the school district budget. The proposed Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) for this year is currently suggested at .7%, reflecting a notable decrease from the previous year.

CBO Hale delivered an update on the current status of the roofs at the Wilson School campus. A consultant was engaged to offer a professional assessment. While the roofs are compromised, there is a one to three-year timeframe before a replacement roof will be installed on the school facilities.

3.4 Report from Catalyst Foundation: Proposed Arts Program

The evening commenced with a presentation by the members Catalyst, a Wilson School foundation. During the presentation, Catalyst board members proposed the implementation of an art program, pledging a generous contribution of \$25,000 to benefit students at Wilson School. The allocated funds will be disbursed through a stipend. Pending approval from the Willmar School Board, efforts will be initiated to search for a qualified part-time teacher to instruct art at Wilson School.
